

JOURNALISM, MASTER OF ARTS (M.A.)

Thesis only: 30 credits

The degree requires 30 credits of coursework and a thesis, which is a critical and scholarly work. Required among the 30 credits are three-credits of research methods, three credits of theory and six credits of master's thesis work. The remaining 18 credits are comprised of elective courses, which may be taken within the College of Journalism or, with approval, in affiliated fields of study within the Graduate School or Washington Consortium.
